Introduction

Rx Take Back (Sign-up)

We will be holding another RX Take-Back in conjunction with the DEA's national Drug Take Back Day on Saturday, April 28, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Everybody's Supermarket in Raymond. Allie has already spoken with the manager of Everybody's, as well as the Raymond and South Bend Police Departments, who will be providing officers to stand at the event. A sign-up sheet was passed around to members who were present. As of now, Erin Frasier and Debbie Elmore are scheduled to sit at the event from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. and Allie Friese is scheduled for 12 to 2 p.m.

Town Hall (Date/speaker)

Katie Lindstrom mentioned Jody McVittie as a possible speaker at the Town Hall. She is relatively local, fairly inexpensive, and comes highly recommended by those who have seen her. She would focus her talk on Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs). It was decided that Allie would contact Jody to see what dates in May she would be free, and then would send out a doodle to coalition members to vote on a definitive date. Once a date is chosen, fliers will be printed and hung, and we will look into radio advertisement. It was also decided that Allie would contact the Chamber to see how much it would cost to rent.

In regards to food, coalition members decided that a potato bar would be an easy, inexpensive option. Providing childcare was discussed, but no decision was reached.

Draw the Line

The Draw the Line projects were discussed again and an ad hoc "social hosting ordinance" committee was created. Erin noted that we need to decide if we want to focus on the City of South Bend, the City of Raymond, or both. It was also mentioned that we need to 100 signatures on a petition, and that it would be effective to have the petition at the upcoming Town Hall.

Katie Lindstrom presented the logic model that we included in the Drug-Free Communities Grant and explained each section. Allie said she would send out the logic model and work plan that were submitted to all coalition members via email.
