- a. - b. Financial Committee

- c. Youth Arm Committee
 - Sources of Strength Week – Nothing planned yet; the online training is about 2-3 hours instead of all day; training has been adapted and is still fun and interactive.

- d. Substance Use Prevention Committee
 - Permanent Drop Boxes – Raymond, Ilwaco, Long Beach, and Ocean Park pharmacies all have drop boxes in their lobbies. Rack cards and magnets with locations are available.
 - Safe Storage – Additional locking medication bags were ordered; will be following up with recipients 60 days after.
 - Rx Drug Take Back Day – October 24th from 10a-2p; will be drive-thru style at Pioneer Grocery in South Bend.
