Substance Use Prevention Committee Meeting Minutes

- 1. RX Drop Boxes** – Denise has been in contact with the MedProject company, which provides drop boxes (kiosks) at no charge. She provided the information and “application” form to South Bend Pharmacy, who is now in the process of receiving a box. Denise mentioned that the kiosk currently in her garage may not have a home in the near future.
- 2. Safe Storage** – regarding the safe storage bags: we are putting a hold on any incoming orders. South County does not have any bags left, and North County only has about 20 left. TAC has \$2,000 they can allocate towards purchasing more bags for North County, and CPAA (PCHHS) has \$750 they can allocate towards South County. Before purchasing more, Denise and Allison will reach out to a few individuals to gauge the effectiveness of the bags.
 - In an effort to gather more information, and do a more targeted approach, we added some additional questions to the initial request form. These include (1) do children reside in, or frequently visit, your household? (2) ages of these children
- 3. Rx Drug Take Back Day** – Saturday, October 24th from 10a-2p. Between 30-40 pounds for South Bend and Shoalwater each, and over 100 pounds (including permanent kiosk) from South County (WellSpring). Table further discussing until the February SUP meeting, in prep for the April Take Back event.
- 4. Bottle Tags / Compliance Checks**– TAC is in the planning process of their bottle tag campaign. Discussion around implementing this campaign alongside alcohol compliance checks. Table until January 2020.
- 5. Prevention Consultants** - no updates at this time. Table until January 2020 meeting.
- 6. Other Business** – Naloxone training, scheduled for 11.20.20, has been cancelled (pending rescheduling) due to Governor Inslee's recent mandates surrounding COVID-19.
- 7. Next Meeting** – January 21st, 2020 at 11:30am.
