1. Rx Drop Boxes

- TAC has \$2,000 allocated for permanent drop boxes and/or prevention.
- There is no update from Sheriff Souvenir regarding the ETA on the permanent drop boxes at the Pacific County Sheriff's offices in Long Beach and South Bend.
- Allison contacted hospital and clinics to see if they accept unused/expired medication. The R2R website has been updated to reflect information below:
 - Ocean Beach Hospital and Clinics – None of their locations accept unused/expired medication
 - Cowlitz Family Health Center (Ocean Park) – patients only
 - Valley View – patients only
 - Willapa Harbor Hospitals and Clinics – to be contacted

2. Opioid Prevention Campaign

- **R2R website:**
 - R2R has \$50 to allocate towards promotion of the Opioid Prevention pages on R2R's website.
 - WellSpring and TAC have dollars they can allocate as well, however, the content need to be pacific-county based rather than only South Bend based.
 - Allison will update the Healthy Youth Survey statistics to focus on Pacific County wide data, rather than South Bend School District data.
- **Lock boxes:**
 - CARA (WellSpring) has \$800 they can reallocate from their professional staff development budget line to lock boxes, pending board approval. Carole will make this request with the board at their next meeting in 3 weeks.
 - MHAT (PCHHS) - funds cannot be used
 - ORT (PCHHA) – ask Katie
 - TAC – funds can only be used for lock boxes provided in North County
 - The Peninsula Pharmacies and South Bend Pharmacy may be able to provide us lock boxes at wholesale price. Carole will inquire with Peninsula Pharmacies and Allison will inquire with South Bend Pharmacy.
 - Carole will do an ask with Peninsula Rotary
