- 1. RX Drop Boxes** – There are new permanent drop boxes in the lobbies of Raymond, Ilwaco, Long Beach, and Ocean Park pharmacies. The old box from the Sheriff's Office is undergoing maintenance prior to delivery to South Bend Pharmacy.
- 2. Opioid Prevention Campaign** – Final share-out was sent Monday, September, 14th.
- 3. Safe Storage** – TAC was able to reallocate some funding and order 58 additional bags; may allocate additional funding in carryover budget. The QR code image to be laminated and posted at permanent drop boxes; Zoe will print for north county and Darian will print for south county. Once bags are distributed, will follow up in 60 days. Initial contact questions were determined; need to establish the follow up questions.
- 4. Rx Drug Take Back Day** – Saturday, October 24th from 10a-2p. Logan will contact law enforcement and confirm times; tentatively Raymond PD from 10a-12p and PCSO from 12p-2p. Darian located the banner and sandwich boards but no garbage can yet; R2R has table cover. Denise will create a Facebook event and add R2R, PCHHS, and law enforcement agencies as co-hosts. Denise will send link for Take Back Day Google sheet to committee. Need to emphasize it's a drive-thru. Logan can secure traffic safety equipment if needed e.g., cones, vest, etc.
