a. Safe Storage Campaign / Medication Lock Bags -

Denise and Allison are working on a trifold to disseminate county-wide, which will list permanent kiosk collection boxes, take back events (when they are), mail back information, and medication lock bags. *“Community Prevention and Protection”*

Also working on a poster to display at pharmacies that will encourage community members to either scan a code to request a bag online, or walk into the pharmacy and get one. Allison and Denise will approach pharmacies later this month.
